

Official Rules

USAgencies Credit Union (USACU) **Checking that Bridges** Drawing

Effective January 4 through March 5, 2010

No Purchase Necessary. All Entries Have an Equal Chance of Winning. These rules are available by downloading from this website (www.usacu.org) or by calling Member Services at 503.275.0300 or 800.452.0915 for a type-written copy.

How to Enter: Open up a new Checking Account between January 4 through March 5, 2010 and you'll automatically be entered into a drawing to win a trip to The Riverhouse in Bend! Only one entry per member of the age of 18 or older is allowed. To enter without opening a checking account: Print your complete name, street address (no P.O. Boxes), city, state, zip code, and the words "Checking That Bridges", day and evening telephone numbers, and email address (optional) on a 3"x5" note card, place in an envelope and mail to: Checking That Bridges Sweepstakes, 95 SW Taylor St. Portland, OR 97204. All entries must be postmarked by 02/26/2010 and received by 03/05/2010. Entrants must be 18 years of age or older. Limit one entry per person.

Prize Drawing Details: On March 8, 2010 USACU will randomly select: ONE winner from all eligible entries received for the trip to Bend. Contact Member Services at 503.275.0300 or 800.452.0915 to arrange for prize pick up information.
